Team Fee Fundraiser Package

In addition to basic player fees, your competitive team will likely have additional team fees. If you are required to pay for additional team fees then this fundraiser package is applicable to you! The package was put together to assist you when you approach friends, family members, and close business associates to ask for their support with your team fees.

Your package includes:

- Power point presentation (pdf #2) on fundraising ideas print off a copy as a resource for ideas
- A standard basic letter (pdf #3) Team Fee Fundraising Letter for the Player you will need to make copies, and don't forget to sign each letter!
- A basic sheet with multiple receipts (pdf #4) you will need to copy and cut out the individual receipts for your donors
- A donor record sheet (pdf #5) keep track of your donations
- Promotional poster (pdf #6) you will need to make copies, leave one for the people/organizations who donate so they can display

Your team manager and/or coach will be your point of contact for any questions or concerns regarding your fundraising. Please communicate directly with them if your have any questions.

It is important that you read through all the materials so that you are clear on how to begin your campaign.

This is not a mandatory method to raise monies for your team fees but rather put in place to help you if you choose to fundraise rather than your parents pay for additional team fees. We hope that you and your parents will regard this as a learning opportunity. You are part of a team!
