Insurance - Helpful Information

Information in the event you need to file a claim

If a player is injured and a parent needs to file a claim for insurance, they will need to submit details about how the injury occurred.

Coaches and parents should document when an injury occurs in the event the parents needs to file a claim for insurance. It is good practice to keep a record. Coaches <u>this</u> <u>injury report form</u> will simply help you to keep a record of an injury when it happens at a practice or development session.

It is the parent's (or injured party if over 18) responsibility to file a claim. Parents should be aware of the deadlines to file and the criteria or application process. <u>Click here</u> to find out how to submit a claim and what is required.

During the outdoor season when playing a sanctioned game, the referee would typically file a special incident report. However, you as a coach should still document an injury and can use the injury report form for your record keeping. Although this club injury report form is not mandatory, it makes good sense to keep records when injuries occur. Due diligence is key!
